**Eucharistic Adoration.** Adoration will be going on during CCD class time as part of the 40 Hours for Life prayer service being conducted this week.

**Lenten Confessions.** Our parish Communal Penance Service is scheduled for Sunday, March 28<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 p.m. The CCD schedule is Wednesday, March 10<sup>th</sup>, March 24<sup>th</sup>, and March 31<sup>st</sup>. Note that the March 10<sup>th</sup> service will be going on in conjunction with our 40 Hours for Life prayer service.

**Adult Education Session.** Thanks to those who attended. It was an interesting topic, "**Mormonism & Jehovah's Witness.**" We discussed briefly the historical background of each religion and their main beliefs. The next session is scheduled for April 7<sup>th</sup>, which will be on "Marian Apparitions."
