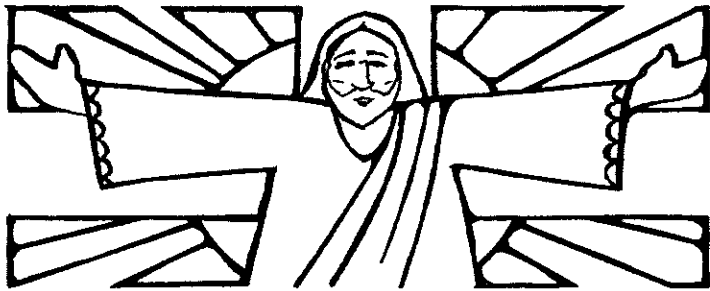

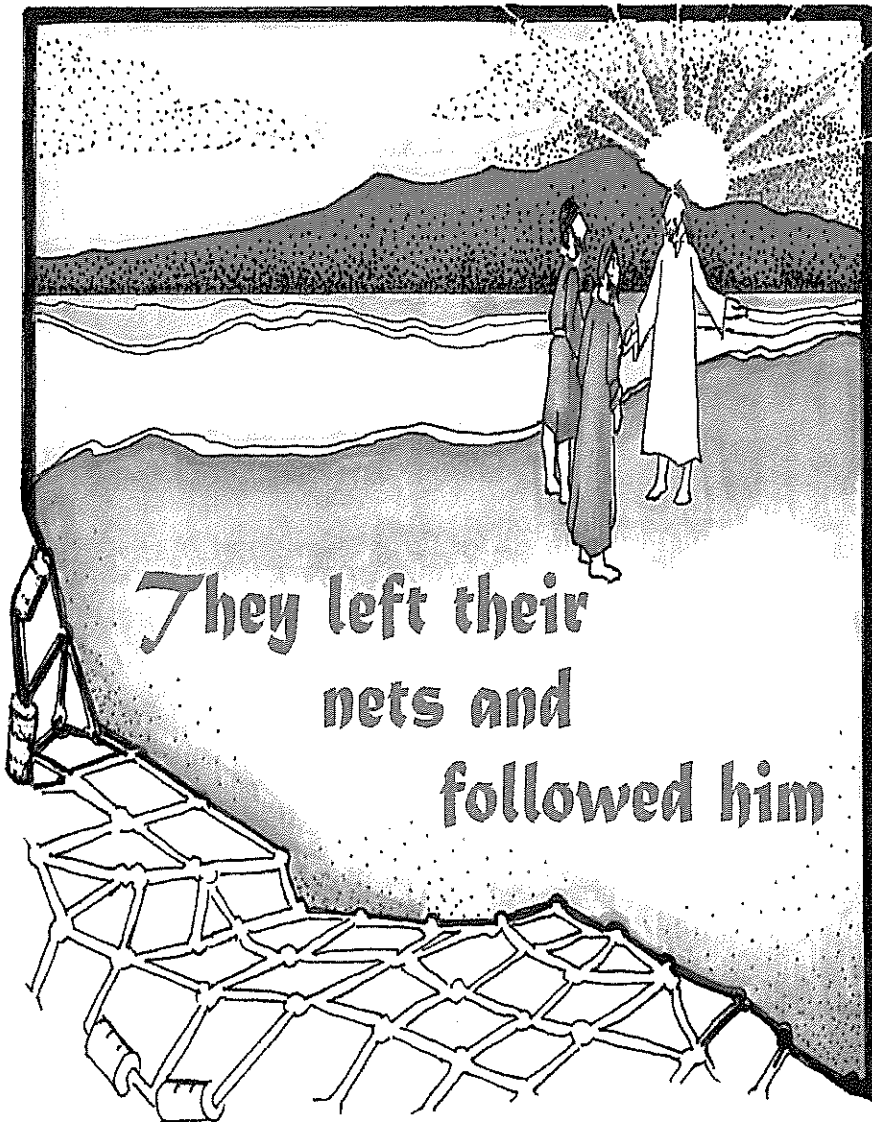

Note from the Pastor...

Feast of St. Blasé. The Feast of St. Blasé, bishop and martyr, is a week from this Monday, February 3rd. It has been a tradition to bless people's throats on this feast. We will have the blessing of the throats after the 5:30 p.m. Mass.

Catholic Schools Week is this week (January 26-February 1). Catholic Schools Week was started 40 years ago to underscore that Catholic schools are a great gift to the Church and to the nation. The theme this year is "Catholic Schools: Communities of Faith, Knowledge and Service." Faith, knowledge, and service are the measures by which Catholic schools can be judged. First, Catholic schools are *communities of faith*. This is the primary reason they exist. Catholic schools partner with parents in the faith formation of their children. Second, Catholic schools are *communities of knowledge*. They provide an education that combines Catholic tradition with academic excellence. Finally, Catholic schools are *communities of service*; they have a rich history of teaching the value of service." (These comments were taken from the National Catholic Educational Association website.)

Archbishop George Lucas of Omaha, Nebraska made the following comments about the importance of Catholic schools: "Catholic schools provide a rich environment of faith and learning where students experience how much God loves them in Christ. They are free to express their own love for God in prayer and the celebration of the sacraments and to express love of neighbor in a community where each is respected as a gift from God. Our students hear Jesus inviting them to be his followers and friends, and they learn how to respond to him with generosity and faith."

Some of the activities during the week include: **Monday**; PJ day. Students may wear their pajamas to school. **Tuesday**; Pastries with parents at 8:00 a.m. **Wednesday**; Mass with the bishop at 11:00 a.m. in Oakley, lunch and activities with Oakley school. **Thursday**; Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary from Wichita will be visiting with the students, it is also crazy hat/sock day and grandparents are invited to eat lunch with students this day. **Friday**; Pioneer Day. Students are encouraged to dress in pioneer wear, cowboy or cowgirl attire. Katera Harter, Miss Rodeo Kansas, will visit this day and do activities with the students.

Rachel's Vineyard – "Walk for a Grieving Heart" Fund Raiser. The Walk for a Grieving Heart event this year is Saturday (February 8th) beginning at 9:00 a.m. We meet in the school gym. 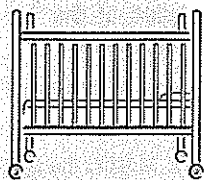

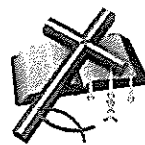
